We acknowledge our environmental responsibility and are committed to continually improving our environmental performance. The company will actively promote the principles of environmentally sound processes and practices through the following measures:

- Meet or exceed all relevant environmental regulatory and other requirements.
- Maintain plant, equipment, store substances and transfer fuel in a manner that prevents pollution.
- Endeavour to segregate our waste and to use recycled material where economically feasible.
- Regulate and improve our activities to cause the least practicable impact on the environment.

- Have emergency plans in place.
